MUSEUM OF LONDON DOCKLANDS

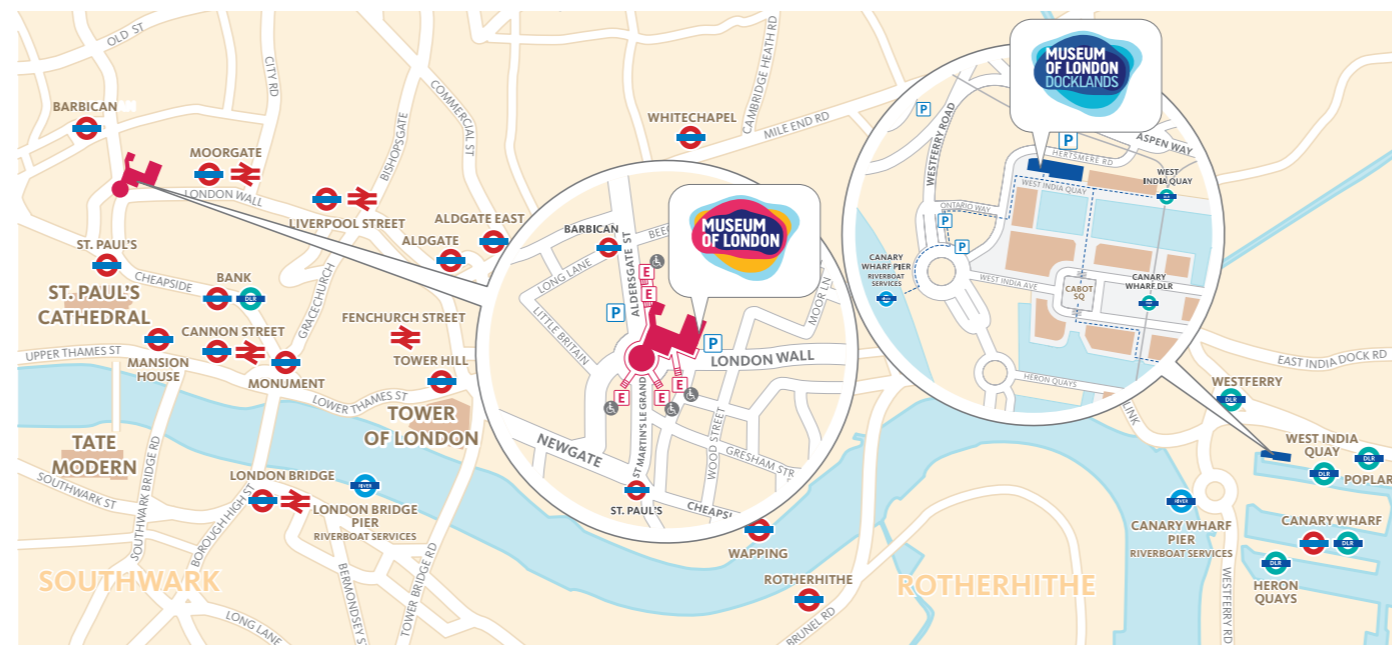
West India Quay, London E14 4AL

Your journey through the history of London isn't complete without a visit to the Museum of London Docklands, which tells the tale of the real East End, the Thames and the capital's past as one of the world's greatest trading cities. Housed in a Grade I listed warehouse, the museum reveals stories of trade, migration and commerce through a wealth of fascinating objects from whale bones to air raid shelters. Galleries include the only permanent exhibition in London to reveal the city's involvement in the transatlantic slave trade, an evocative recreation of 19th century riverside London and our interactive children's gallery **Mudlarks**.
